Our Keynote Speaker is **Dr. Nadine Lemmon**, Albany Legislative Advocate, Tri-State Transportation Campaign (TSTC). Nadine joined TSTC in March 2010 as the organization's first Albany-based staffer. She is working to advance sustainable transportation policies at the state level to ensure safer streets, improved bus service, and adequate transit funding.

Since 2001, Nadine has been involved in politics and land use advocacy in New York's Hudson Valley. As a two-term elected official in Gardiner, NY, Nadine worked to pass and implement smart growth zoning laws and she was the project manager on a \$1.6M Federally funded sidewalk improvement project. As a member of the Region 8 MPO, the Ulster County Transportation Council, Nadine helped oversee all Federally funded transportation projects in the county, including ARRA-funded projects.

Prior to getting involved in local politics, Nadine was an Adjunct Professor at City College in NYC and the Founder and Executive Director of the Gunk Foundation, an operating foundation that specializes in supporting and promoting public art projects internationally.

Nadine Received a BA in Economics from Duke University, and MFA in Photography the Scholol of Visual Arts, and a Ph.D in Sociology from the CUNY Graduate Center.
